HERE TO HELP Bullying affects
lots of young people and happens in
many schools but it's the way it's dealt
with which makes the difference
between life being tolerable or a
misery. Bullying is usually defined as
repeated behaviour which is intended
to hurt someone either emotionally or
physically. It can take many forms
including physical assault, teasing,
making threats, name calling or cyber
bullying. It can happen anywhere: at
school, travelling to and from school,
in sporting teams, between neighbours
or in the workplace. If you are being
bullied at school, tell a friend, tell a
teacher and tell your parents. It won't
stop unless you do. It can be hard to
do this so if you don't feel you can do
it in person it might be easier to write
a note to your parents explaining how
you feel, or perhaps confide in
someone outside the immediate
family, like a grandparent, aunt, uncle
or cousin and ask them to help you
tell your parents what's going on.
Don't be tempted to respond to any
bullying or hit back because you
could get hurt or get into trouble. For
