HERE TO HELP

Drug Use. The Public Health Agency warns that taking any drugs which have not been prescribed to you by your doctor can result in death or permanent damage to your health. Highly dangerous substances are present in many drugs (www.talktofrank.com) being sold on our streets regardless of the "brand" or assurances given by people selling them. Taking drugs over several days, using more than one drug and mixing drugs with alcohol is extremely risky. It is particularly dangerous to take drugs if you are on your own, are ill, very tired or depressed, are on medication, have taken alcohol or have a medical condition such as asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, high blood pressure, mental illness or heart disease. If you do take drugs it is very important that your friends know exactly what these are and can tell emergency services immediately.
